The Southern Conference on Language Teaching (SCOLT) has named Horst Kurz, Associate Professor of German at Georgia Southern University, as the 2011 SCOLT Post-Secondary Teacher-of-Excellence at the 2011 SCOLT Conference in Baton Rouge. The annual award was presented at the Awards Luncheon, March 11, 2011.

Horst Kurz studied German Literature, Philosophy, and Political Science in Germany at Universitaet Augsburg. In 1984, he transferred to Ohio State and completed the MA and PhD. He taught from 1989 to 1993 at the College of Wooster (OH); then he joined the Department of Foreign Languages at Georgia Southern University. He is a member of numerous associations and has been and continues to be involved in various activities (for example, ACTFL, MALCA, MERLOT, ...). He is especially active in the American Association of Teachers of German (AATG) GA Chapter, the Foreign Language Association of Georgia (FLAG), and SCOLT. Professor Kurz is familiar to many language professionals throughout the SCOLT region and beyond through his frequent presentations and presence at various language functions as well as his publications and materials for teachers of German.
